

## **M.C. Dean Renovates & Restores Historical Courthouse**

*M.C. Dean begins work on Moultrie Courthouse as Prime Contractor*

**Dulles, Va., Nov. 18, 2011** – M.C. Dean, Inc., the nation's leading engineering and technology service firm for mission-critical systems and facilities, was recently awarded prime contractor of a \$25 million contract for the upgrades and renovations of Moultrie Courthouse, the Superior Court of the District of Columbia.

The scope includes replacement of the electrical infrastructure to include high voltage switch line-up, double-ended substations, generators, paralleling gear, switchboards, risers, and panel boards. To achieve this upgrade, other areas and systems will require major modifications. These major modifications include expanding the substation rooms, raising part of the penthouse roof, relocation of sanitary lines inside and outside of the building, building an acoustically-isolated generator room within the penthouse, building utility chases in the elevator lobbies, replacing the underground fuel storage tank, and installing new fuel distribution system to the room.

Kimball Construction, Inc. is the subcontractor of civil work and Southland Industry, Inc. is the subcontractor of mechanical and sprinkler systems.

The project began in September 2011. The Moultrie Courthouse will remain fully operational and occupied during construction. M.C. Dean is diligently maintaining the buildings services for the 2,000 people that use the building every day. The scheduled completion date is July 2013.
